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## ROBERT J. KANER, MD

Topic: **Scleroderma Interstitial Lung Disease & Emerging Therapies**

Dr. Kaner is Associate Attending Physician at the New York Presbyterian Weill Cornell Center and Associate Professor of Clinical Medicine and Genetic Medicine at Weill Cornell Medical College. He has interstitial lung disease expertise and is medical director of the Ventilator Management Team.

Dr. Kaner is the Principal Investigator of the Weill-Cornell site of the National Institute of Health.

He is the project leader of an NIH-sponsored study of the molecular basis of accelerated emphysema development in HIV-1 positive smokers and served as principal investigator of NIH-sponsored basic research in mechanisms of vascular permeability in the lung and interactions of human alveolar macrophages with HIV-1.

Dr. Kaner is committed to research into the application of cutting edge molecular techniques to advance the understanding of pathophysiology, as well as to further improve the diagnosis and treatment of lung disease. He is board certified in internal medicine, pulmonary disease and critical care medicine.



## THERESA LU, MD, PHD

Topic: **Improving Adipose-Derived Stem Cell Therapy in Scleroderma**

Dr. Theresa Lu is a pediatric rheumatologist in New York, New York. She received her medical degree from Yale University School of Medicine and has been in practice for over twenty years. She is involved in diagnosing and treating childhood arthritis, juvenile rheumatoid arthritis, scleroderma, systemic lupus erythematosus, Kawasaki Disease and other rheumatic diseases of

the joints, soft tissue, and connective tissue.

Dr. Lu is the lead study author of new and ongoing research at Hospital for Special Surgery in New York City that has identified a possible mechanism behind the fibrosis that occurs in scleroderma – a mechanism that may one day lead to a treatment for the disease.

Dr. Lu is a standing member of the NIH Inflammation of the Cardiovascular System Study Section and of the American Society of Clinical Investigators. She is the recipient of the Jean Davis Grant from the Alliance for Lupus Research. She was also the recipient of the American College of Rheumatology's Henry Kunkel Young Investigator Award in 2011 and of the Cornell Graduate School's Teaching and Mentoring Award in 2010.
