- **LOOSE CHANGE** – Put containers out at retail businesses to collect loose change.
- **MOM PROM** – Put on your old prom dress, those old bridesmaid dresses, or even your wedding dress and dance the evening away for scleroderma! (Invite men if you want.)
- **JEANS 4 A CURE** – Get coworkers in your office to pay \$5 to wear jeans to work.
- **PARENTS NIGHT OUT/CHRISTMAS SHOPPING** – Charge parents for babysitting.
